The Street Department has one vacancy that will be filled from this announcement.

Position Responsibilities (include but are not limited to the following):

- Maintain daily work sheets of assigned tasks.
- Clean and Maintain City Property and Rights of Way as needed.
- Responsible for pothole patching, storm clean up, snow removal, weed eating, and/or any other task assigned by a supervisor.
- Shall maintain a presentable appearance; respectfully speak with citizens, co-workers and supervisors.
- Shall be available in case of emergencies such as snowfall and storm conditions or anything else deemed an emergency requiring a street department personnel response by the administration.
- Report any and all needed repairs of equipment.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities Required:

- Ability to appropriately use equipment
- Ability to adhere to the rules and regulations of the department, the City of Terre Haute and the State of Indiana.
- Ability to work well with other department employees and other city personnel.
- Ability to work well with the public and always be respectful.
- Working knowledge of the proper use of chainsaws, pole saws, weed eaters, blowers, personal safety equipment, etc.

Minimum Qualifications:

- **Education/Training:** High School Diploma or Equivalent.
- **Experience:** At least 1 year experience operating heavy equipment.
- **Applicants with a valid “Class A” Commercial Drivers License are preferred.**

Working Conditions: Frequently required to be outdoors in extreme cold and extreme hot weather.

Physical Requirements:

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an individual to successfully perform the essential functions of this job.

- Regularly required to talk or hear.

- Shall require extended periods of standing and/or walking.
- Shall require periods of pulling/pushing items, lifting and carrying items, stooping, and kneeling.
- Shall be able to lift and/or move up to 50 pounds.
