



PROCLAMATION

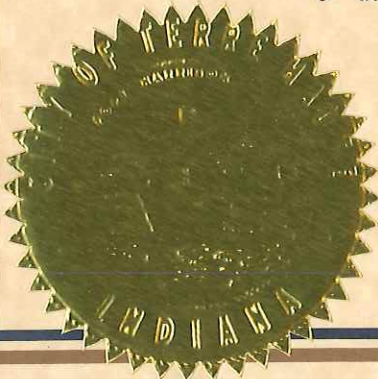
- WHEREAS: each year, approximately a million pregnancies in the U.S. end in miscarriage, stillbirth or the death of a newborn; and

- WHEREAS: Union Hospital RTS Bereavement Services program is a comprehensive support program that is designed to help parents deal constructively with their loss as well as increase public awareness and sensitivity to bereaving families; and
