A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING A PORTION OF EAGLE STREET AS THE "SGT. KYLE CHILDRESS OIF MEMORIAL WAY" AND A PORTION OF EAGLE STREET AS THE "SGT. DALE GRIFFIN OEF MEMORIAL WAY."

WHEREAS, the City of Terre Haute, Indiana, from time to time has designated certain roadways in honor of individuals for their accomplishments or contributions to the City; and

WHEREAS, Sgt. Kyle Childress was a 1994 graduate of Terre Haute South Vigo High School where he played football; and

WHEREAS, Sgt. Kyle Childress went on to join the United States Army and was subsequently deployed to Iraq during Operation Iraqi Freedom; and

WHEREAS, Sgt. Kyle Childress, while in service to his country and his deployment to Iraq, gave the ultimate sacrifice and passed away due to wounds he received in combat on January 21, 2005; and

WHEREAS, Sgt. Kyle Childress' service will serve as a constant reminder of the great cost of our freedom and security and we honor his service and sacrifice; and

WHEREAS, Sgt. Dale Griffin was a graduate of Terre Haute South High School where he was renowned as a champion wrestler, going on to be named the Most Outstanding Wrestler at the 2000 All-Academy Wrestling Championship; and

WHEREAS, Sgt. Dale Griffin went on to join the United States Army in 2005 after attending the Virginia Military Institute and was subsequently deployed to Afghanistan during Operation Enduring Freedom; and

WHEREAS, Sgt. Dale Griffin, while in service to his country and his deployment to Afghanistan, gave the ultimate sacrifice and passed away due to wounds he received in combat on October 27, 2009; and

WHEREAS, Sgt. Dale Griffin's service will serve as a constant reminder of the great cost of our freedom and security and we honor his service and sacrifice; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council and the City of Terre Haute wish to preserve the memory of these proud servicemen near the Veterans of Foreign Wars facility immediately adjacent to Eagle Street.


BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that Eagle Street between 11th and 12th Street shall be

designated the "Sgt. Kyle Childress OIF Memorial Way" and Eagle Street between 12th and 13th Street shall be designated the "Sgt. Dale Griffin OEF Memorial Way"; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Public Works and Safety, while not changing Eagle Street's designation or signage, be directed to prepare signs indicating such memorial and having them placed at appropriate points along the way.


