We are writing to voice our opinion of a possible street closure on the eastside of Terre Haute. This street (27<sup>th</sup>) has been used by the neighborhood as a safe walkway and bikeway for generations and seldom is used by vehicles. We use this street frequently when walking to Baeslers, the Meadows and the church playground. As you know, 29<sup>th</sup> street is not walkable due to the high volume of traffic and no sidewalks.
