Re: Request for Appropriation of Funds

April 19, 2022

The Terre Haute Police Department is requesting an appropriation of funds, totaling \$25,000, from the Police Pension Fund 0703-0064 to the Medical/Surgical/Dental 0703-0006-03-432060.

The funds are being requested to cover expenses related to the medical testing of employees provided a conditional offer of employment in calendar year 2022. The cost per individual is roughly \$1,525.43 with our Department recently hiring 8 officers. The total invoice for their testing was \$12,203.44. Additionally, the Indiana Public Retirement System is now requiring follow-up pulmonary function testing for officers hired in 2020 and early 2021. This testing was not conducted at that time due to Covid-19 concerns. If approved, this appropriation will cover the medical testing expenses for the aforementioned officers along with any additional individuals given a conditional offer of employment requiring medical testing. This medical testing is required for officers to be accepted into the Indiana Public Retirement System.
