SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 54, 2010

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 31, 2010, TO AMEND THE SALARIES FOR THE CEMETERY DEPARTMENT FOR THE CITY OF TERRE HAUTE, INDIANA, FOR 2011, TO TAKE EFFECT ON JANUARY 1, 2011.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of Terre Haute, Indiana:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to a Transit Utility arbitration award issued on November 12, 2010, and an agreement to honor that arbitration award for all city employees, the City is required to increase wages by 2.1%.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> Therefore, Special Ordinance No. 29, 2010, passed on September 28, 2010, is hereby amended by deleting the stricken text and inserting the underlined text as follows:

SECTION 1. Commencing January 1, 2011, the following salary schedule shall be in full force and effect for the Cemetery Department of the City of Terre Haute as follows:

Regular Employees

\$ 14.16 \$14.46 per hour

Temporary or Probationary Employees & Summer Help

\$ 10.30 <u>\$10.52</u> per hour

SECTION 3. All other remaining section of the original salary ordinance shall remain unchanged.

SECTION 4. The illegality or invalidity, for any reason, of any of the sections of this ordinance, or parts thereof, shall invalidate only such section or sections as are so determined to be illegal or invalid, and any such invalidity shall have no effect on the remaining sections of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. This amendment shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and shall be effective as in the salaries provided on and for January 1, 2011.
