AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 33, 2010, AS AMENDED, TO AMEND THE SALARIES OF ALL EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF TERRE HAUTE, INDIANA, EXCEPTING SOME MEMBERS OF THE TERRE HAUTE FIRE DEPARTMENT, THE TERRE HAUTE POLICE DEPARTMENT, THE TERRE HAUTE STREET DEPARTMENT, THE TERRE HAUTE CEMETERY DEPARTMENT, THE TERRE HAUTE WASTEWATER UTILITY, THE TERRE HAUTE TRANSPORTATION UTILITY, THE TERRE HAUTE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT, AND EXCLUDING ELECTED OFFICIALS, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2011.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of Terre Haute, Indiana:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to a Transit Utility arbitration award issued on November 12, 2010, and an agreement to honor that arbitration award for all city employees, the City is required to increase wages by 2.1%.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> Therefore, Special Ordinance No. 33, 2010, as amended, passed on September 28, 2010, is hereby amended by deleting the stricken text and inserting the underlined text as follows:

SECTION 1. Commencing January 1, 2011, the following salary schedule shall be in full force and effect for the designated Municipal Employees of the City of Terre Haute by Department, as follows:

<u>SECTION 5.</u> All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. This amendment shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and shall be effective as in the salaries provided on and for January 1, 2011.
