

SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 3, 2011

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 33, 2010, AS AMENDED, TO CREATE A CIVILIAN MECHANIC POSITION IN THE TERRE HAUTE FIRE DEPARTMENT, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2011.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of Terre Haute, Indiana:

SECTION 1. Special Ordinance No. 33, 2010, as amended, is hereby further amended by the insertion of the underlined text to create a civilian mechanic position in the Terre Haute Fire Department:

FIRE DEPARTMENT - CIVILIANS:

Chief Secretary	\$ 29,572
Clerk / Typist	\$ 29,572
Data Entry Clerk	\$ 29,572
<u>Mechanic</u>	<u>\$ 43,680</u>

SECTION 2. All other remaining section of the original salary ordinance shall remain unchanged.

SECTION 3. The illegality or invalidity, for any reason, of any of the sections of this ordinance, or parts thereof, shall invalidate only such section or sections as are so determined to be illegal or invalid, and any such invalidity shall have no effect on the remaining sections of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This amendment shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and shall be effective as in the salaries provided on and for January 1, 2011.
