GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 7, 2006

As Amended

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING *TERRE HAUTE CITY CODE* CHAPTER 2, SEC. 2-65 HUMAN RELATIONS COMMISSION.

SECTION I. BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Terre Haute that Chapter 2, Sec. 2-65 Human Relations Commission of the *Terre Haute City Code* is hereby amended by deleting the stricken text and inserting the underlined text as follows:

Sec. 2-65 Human Relations Commission.

. . .

a. Establishment; Membership, Vacancies

• • •

- (2) The commission shall consist of seven (7) members-, not more than four (4) of whom shall be members of the same political party. Three (3) of whom shall be appointed by the Common Council and four (4) of whom shall be appointed by the Mayor.
 - b. Qualifications of Members.
- (1) All members shall be residents the City of Terre Haute <u>or a property owner within</u> the City of Terre Haute and who also resides within Vigo County. The Mayor and Common Council shall make only those appointments which ensure:

(C) The appointment shall be in such manner that the number of members of the Commission belonging to one of the two major political parties shall not exceed by more than one the number of those belonging to the other major political party, and the Mayor and the Common Council shall take this into consideration in making their respective appointments; provided, however, that if they cannot agree upon the manner in which such representation is to be attained, the Mayor shall make that appointment which shall result in one of the major political parties having the greater number of members on the Board.

SECTION II. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

WHEREAS, an emergency exists for the immediate taking effect of the Ordinance, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of Terre Haute, Indiana and its approval by the Mayor and publication as required by law.
