AN ORDINANCE OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRE HAUTE, INDIANA AMENDING CHAPTER 9, ARTICLE 5 "SEWER RATES AND CHARGES" OF THE TERRE HAUTE CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Terre Haute, Indiana:

SECTION 1. That Sec. 9-99 is hereby amended by inserting the underlined text as follows:

Sec. 9-99 Minimum Charges.

The water usage schedule and the applicable sewage rates and charges based thereon shall be as follows:

(1) One dollar and twenty cents (\$1.20) per one hundred (100) cubic feet of water used or sewage discharged is the rate inside the City.

(2) A minimum charge for any user inside the City shall be three dollars and seventy-five cents (\$3.75) per month or quarter according to the billing period, except that where the user is not a metered water consumer, the minimum charge shall be determined by means and methods satisfactory to the City.

(3) One dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) per one hundred (100) cubic feet of water used or sewage discharged is the rate outside the City.

(4) A minimum charge for any user outside the City shall be four dollars and seventy cents (\$4.70) per month or quarter according to the billing period, except that where the user is not a metered water consumer, the minimum charge shall be determined by means and methods satisfactory to the City.

(5) Except that all domestic non-commercial non-industrial users inside the City with nonmetered water source shall pay a flat rate of thirty dollars and sixty-five cents (\$30.65) per quarter.

(6) Except that all domestic non-commercial non-industrial users outside the City with nonmetered water source shall pay a flat rate of thirty-eight dollars and thirty-one cents (\$38.31) per quarter.

(7) The City of Terre Haute, its departments and agencies are exempt from the payment of the sewage rates listed in Section 9-99.

SECTION 2. WHEREAS, an emergency exists for the immediate taking effect of the ordinance, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of Terre Haute, Indiana and approval of the Mayor and publication as required by law.
