WHEREAS:	Susan G. Komen® has set a goal to reduce the current number of breast cancer deaths in the United States by 50% by the year 2026; and
WHEREAS:	this morning, October 2, 2017, we gather in front the Vigo County Courthouse, where four pink ribbons are illuminated on the dome to honor those who have battled and continue to battle breast cancer.
