

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS:

the month of March, 2021, has been designated as "Disability

Awareness Month" to celebrate and recognize people with disabilities by

the Governor of the State of Indiana; and

WHEREAS:

disability is a natural part of the human experience and in no way diminishes the right of individuals to live independently, enjoy self-determination, make choices, contribute to society and fully experience the economic, political, social, cultural and educational mainstream of American society; and

WHEREAS:

family members, friends and members of the community can play a central role in enhancing the lives of people with disabilities, especially when the family and community are provided with the necessary support services; and public and private employers are aware of the capabilities of people with disabilities to be engaged in competitive work in inclusive settings; and

WHEREAS:

the goals of the City of Terre Haute and the State of Indiana properly include providing individuals with disabilities the opportunities and support to make informed choices and decisions; live in homes and communities where such individuals can exercise their full rights and responsibilities as citizens; pursue meaningful and productive lives; contribute to their family, community, State and Nation; have interdependent friendships and relationships with others; and achieve full inclusion in society.

NOW, THEREFORE: I, Duke A Bennett, Mayor of the City of Terre Haute, do hereby proclaim the month of March, 2021 as

DISABILITY AWARENESS MONTH

and call upon all citizens to observe the month with appropriate programs and activities; furthermore, I encourage the citizens of Terre Haute to seek counsel and input from any person or group with knowledge and expertise in matters concerning disabilities.
