WHEREAS:	it became her mission to help these girls in need. She started mentoring girls one on one and eventually the program grew into visiting schools, juvenile centers and events, teaching about how to deal with bullying issues; and
WHEREAS:	at Girls of Excellence, their mission is to produce girls of character that become role models in their circles of influence. They want to prevent bullying before it happens and instill in students respect; for authority, others, and themselves.
