



## PROCLAMATION

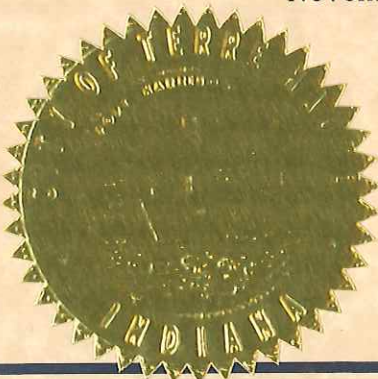

- WHEREAS: an increase in community awareness is necessary to put a stop to the diabetes epidemic.


NOW, THEREFORE: I, Duke A Bennett, Mayor of the City of Terre Haute, do hereby proclaim November, 2016 as
