

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS:	more than nineteen percent of Hoosiers are people with disabilities, and their families and friends extend into a statewide network touching us all; and
WHEREAS:	our communities are stronger and enriched when all members are empowered to live, work and play in accessible, welcoming environments; and
WHEREAS:	in order to increase awareness, promote independence, integration and inclusion of all people with disabilities, the Indiana Governor's Council for People with Disabilities established the month of March as Disabilities Awareness Month; and
WHEREAS:	the theme for the 2018 observance of Disabilities Awareness Month is "Be cool. We are.", which calls each of us to recognize that people with disabilities are co-workers, classmates and neighbors who want to be fully included in their communities—just like everyone else; and
WHEREAS:	the Disability Awareness Work Group, is a collaboration of agencies, individuals and caregivers, formed in 2010 to promote activities and awareness year round through a variety of events and services.
THEREFORE:	I, Duke A Bennett, Mayor of the City of Terre Haute, do hereby proclaim March, 2018, as
