NOW, THEREFORE: I, Duke A Bennett, Mayor of the City of Terre Haute, do hereby proclaim the month of October 2021 as

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AWARENESS MONTH

in remembrance of those who have been killed by abusive partners. I urge all citizens to actively support the activities and programs sponsored by the Council on Domestic Abuse and to work toward the prevention and elimination of domestic violence and abuse.
