WHEREAS:	Wabash Valley Goodwill Industries, Inc. was founded in 1927 by Reverend Theodore Grob, Sr. where he served as Executive Director until 1968; and
WHEREAS:	Theodore Grob Jr. served as Executive Director from 1968 until 1982 at which time, William Tennis began serving as President and CEO in 1982 and continues to serve today; and
WHEREAS:	Goodwill operates 10 locations in the Wabash Valley and provides approximately 185 job opportunities for people with employment barriers; and
WHEREAS:	Goodwill stores sell used clothing, books and household items at discount prices; and
WHEREAS:	their recycling program has diverted millions of pounds of unwanted items from entering the landfills; and
WHEREAS:	Goodwill's medical equipment loaner program provides help for folks in need of items such as walkers, wheelchairs and crutches.
