

## PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS:	Being an organ donor can save up to eight lives and being a tissue donor can heal up to 75 people; and
WHEREAS:	in Indiana, more than 1,200 Hoosiers are currently awaiting a lifesaving organ transplant; and
WHEREAS:	nearly 4.3 million Hoosiers are registered to be organ, tissue and eye donors but more Hoosiers are needed to give the gift of life; and
WHEREAS:	Indiana Donor Network is the federally designated organ recovery organization that coordinates organ, tissue and cornea donation in Indiana and transplantation throughout the U.S; and
WHEREAS:	Indiana Donor Network's mission is to save and enhance the quality of life through organ, tissue and eye donation and transplantation and its vision is to be an innovative leader in saving and healing Hoosier lives through organ and tissue recovery; and
WHEREAS:	April is National Donate Life Month in the U.S., a time to reflect on making a selfless choice to register to become an organ and tissue donor and save and heal lives.

NOW, THEREFORE: I, Duke A Bennett, Mayor of the City of Terre Haute, do hereby proclaim April 1, 2023 as
