

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS:	the National Registry of Historical Landmarks and the State of Indiana Register of Historical Landmarks has designated the building at 321 N. 7 th Street known as United Campus Ministries, as a Historic Landmark in 2022; and
WHEREAS:	the Wesley Foundation building housing the United Ministries in Higher Education in the Terre Haute Area, known as United Campus Ministries has served the entire community of Terre Haute, Indiana and especially the students, faculty and staff of Indiana State University, Ivy Tech Community College, Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology, and St. Mary-of-the Woods College for over 75 years; and
WHEREAS:	the building, built in 1965, and currently owned by Centenary United Methodist Church, has been officially designated as a Historic Landmark and excellent example of Mid-Century Architecture in the Terre Haute area; and
WHEREAS:	the ministry in that building has provided a safe and open space and programs for all students, domestic and international, of all denominations, and faiths, as well as for faculty, staff and the community of Terre Haute and Vigo County; and
WHEREAS:	that ministry has provided food, spiritual, financial and emotional assistance; and
WHEREAS:	it is the goal of that ministry to continue to provide the above in the same ecumenical way into the future.

NOW, THEREFORE: I, Duke A Bennett, Mayor of the City of Terre Haute, do hereby proclaim this day of October 17th, 2022 as

in Terre Haute, Indiana.
